

42nd Annual Alberta Junior Angus Show Bashaw, AB August 13 - 15, 2017



Rules and Guidelines

1. **Entry Fee** : \$25 per class up to July 15, 2017 (guaranteed show apparel), after **July 15, 2017 \$45 per class**
2. Show is open to juniors world wide, 21 years and under as of January 1, 2017. Animals must be **owned** by exhibitor as of July 15, 2017 (unless entered in the Tiny Mite, Pee Wee or Open Class).
3. **All cattle including calendar year calves MUST be registered to be eligible to show.** Tattoos must be legible.
4. The AJAA and/or Bashaw Ag Society and/or members are not responsible for accident or loss.
5. Paint/dye products are not allowed in the show and any animals treated with product will be disqualified from the show.
6. **Adult participation is discouraged.** Ask an Alberta Junior Angus director if you require help.
7. Animals may only be shown in **one** class (excluding Tiny Mite & Pee Wee classes).
8. Tiny Mite & Pee Wee's show in the classes in their respective age division only. Animals can be purebred or commercial.
9. One entry form per exhibitor.
10. There is zero alcohol allowed in the white fence during the AJAA show. (Including Washrack)
11. Bring Bedding as **ZERO** is supplied and Generator as power is **LIMITED**

Commercial Cattle

1. Animals entered in the commercial division **MUST** show Angus Characteristics. A committee will be designated to assess the significance of Angus influence in commercial entries. The committee has the power and duty to disqualify any animals deemed to be showing very little or no Angus influence. The committee's decision is final.
2. When entering a sire and dam **MUST** be entered (if neither are registered, acknowledge breed composition. Example: Angus, Angus/Simmental, etc)

Triple Crown Angus

Same Animal/Same Exhibitor showing Angus at all 3 shows - Summer Synergy, AJAA show & All Breeds - will accumulate points and the High Point animal will claim the title of 2017 Triple Crown Purebred Angus or 2017 Triple Crown Commercial Angus and the coveted Buckles!

Competitions at the show...

Individual Judging - oral reasons - 2 classes will be judged by Juniors & Seniors - Judging is **Mandatory**.
-1 class for Pee Wee

Showmanship – sign up and classes will be posted

Team Judging - teams sign up and a schedule will be posted

Individual Judging -

Photography - you have until 4 pm on Monday to get your **BEST SHOT!**

You can use one of the cameras supplied or we will give you an e-mail address to send us your photo (taken during the show Aug 14-16)
They will then be judged on quality of content related to theme, clarity, unique technique, overall impression.

****BRING WITH YOU TO THE SHOW COMPLETED****

Marketing – Jr & Sr - you are at a show, be ready to sell your animals and promote your program

Bring promotional materials you have designed yourself for your marketing

AJAA Creative Components:

You can bring as many as you like, but one in each category must be designated to be judged

All creative components must include **Angus or Angus influenced material**

Artwork

Original work created by the exhibitor.

Flat (Examples - pencil, paper, paint, etc) – all ages
3-Dimensional (Examples - wood, clay etc) – all ages

Scrapbook

Awards to the top Tiny Mite/Pee Wee, Junior & Senior.

Stall Award

***** All exhibitors must have stall cards for each animal (including calves on cows) *****

Judged on stall cleanliness, design & information - Animal cleanliness & treatment - Exhibitor friendliness, knowledge and cooperation
Remember the purpose of shows is to promote your program – let's see what you can do!!

Premier Exhibitor

Highest points accumulated from all animals from one exhibitor
